3 rd Session.	Subsistence systems of ancient and traditional societies (Chair – RAS Member, Dr. V.I. Molodin, secretary – Dr. I.Y. Chikunova)
4 th Session.	Ecological anthropology (Chair – Dr. A.N. Bagashev, secretary – Dr. V.N. Adaev)
5 th Session.	Cultural landscapes (Chair – Dr. O.N.Trapeznikova, secretary – Dr. S.V. Rasskasov)

The proceedings of the conference will be published before its beginning. The reports to be submitted in Russian or English. Organizing committee retains the right to refuse publication of the reports that do not match the announced topics of the conference.

The book of reports will be indexed article by article in Russian scientific citation index, and will be available on the web site of the organizers.

Text formatting requirements:

- Total volume of the text, including the list of references, should not exceed 6 pages of A4 format (10 000 characters, not accounting for the interword spaces).
- Margins: top and left 3 см, right 1,5 см, bottom 2,5 см.
- Font Times New Roman 14 pt with 1,5 line spacing interval.
- In the center of the first line author/ authors, second line full name of the organization, third line location (city) and country, fourth line— email address (or email addresses of authors), fifth line name of the report **in non-Caps**, bold. Empty line follows.
- Abstract, not less than 200 words, in *italics* (in English).
- The references to the used sources inside the text to be given in the square brackets. Example: [Ivanov, 1989, p. 5], [Cultural essays, 1992, p. 8]
- The illustrations/figures (resolution not less than 300 dpi) to be sent as separate files in the following formats: TIFF, JPG, PNG (name of the figure to be given at the end of the text)
- The list of references to be given at the end of the text in alphabetical order, with Russianlanguage references to be given at the beginning of the list.
